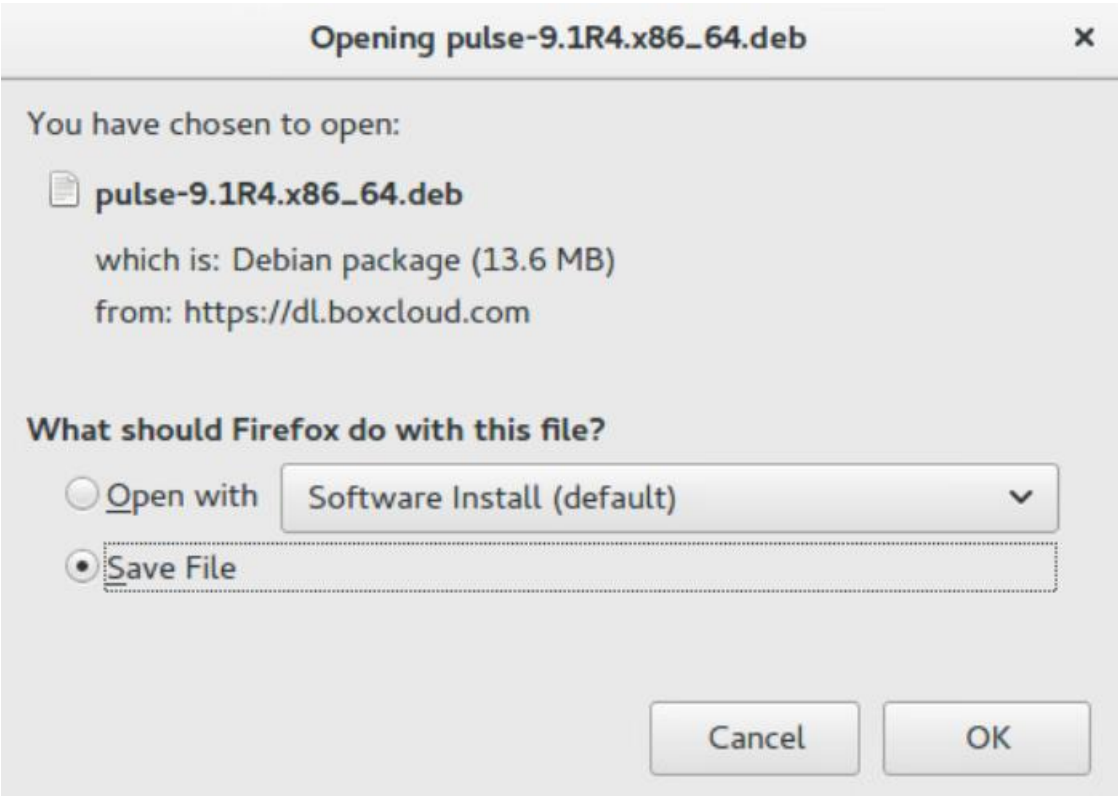
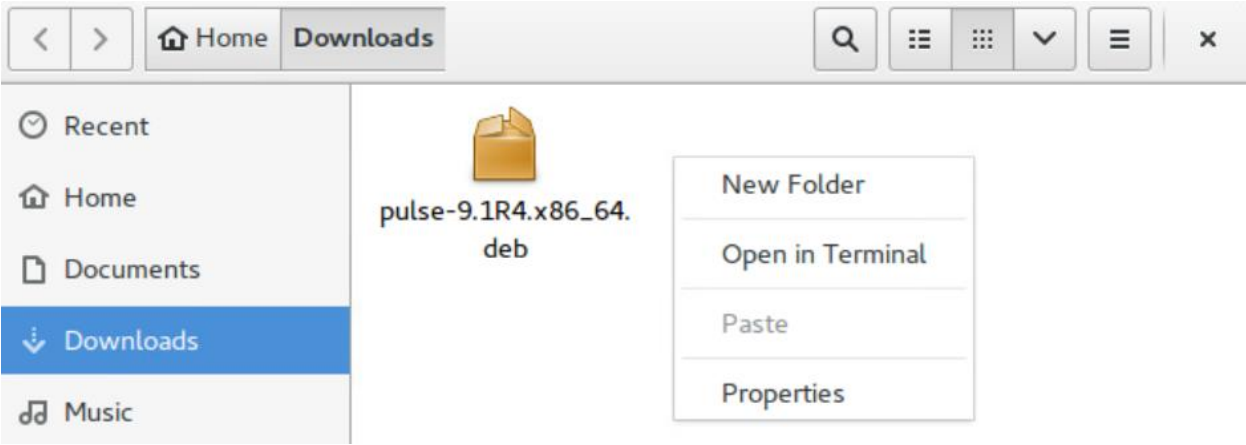


Pulse Secure Ubuntu 16.04 Install Guide

First, ensure that the Pulse Secure 16.04 Deb installer is downloaded and saved to the system by clicking "Save File"



Navigate to the folder in your file explorer and right click anywhere other than on the package, selecting the "Open in Terminal" option.



Run the following commands:

```
mv pulse-*.deb /tmp/
```

```
cd /tmp
```

```
sudo apt install ./pulse-*.deb
```

```
sudo /usr/local/pulse/PulseClient_x86_64.sh install_dependency_packages
```

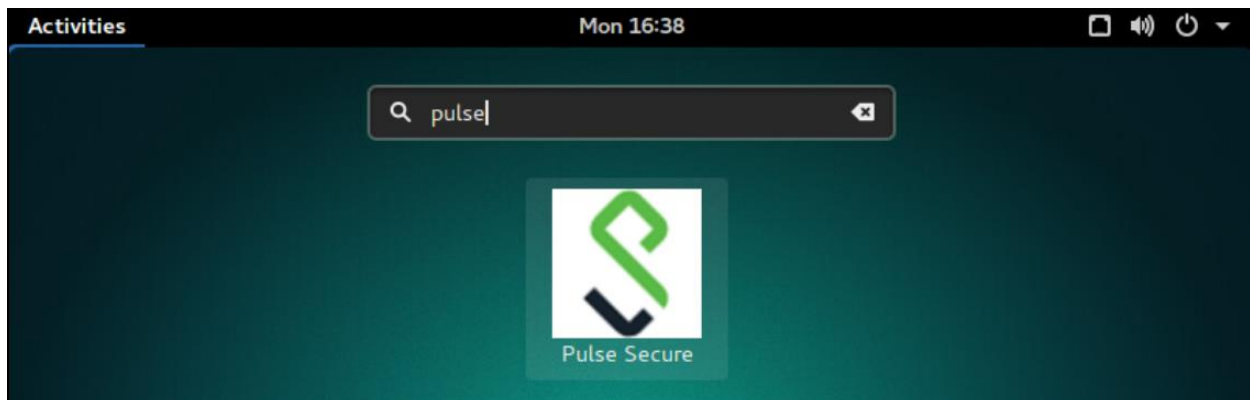

```

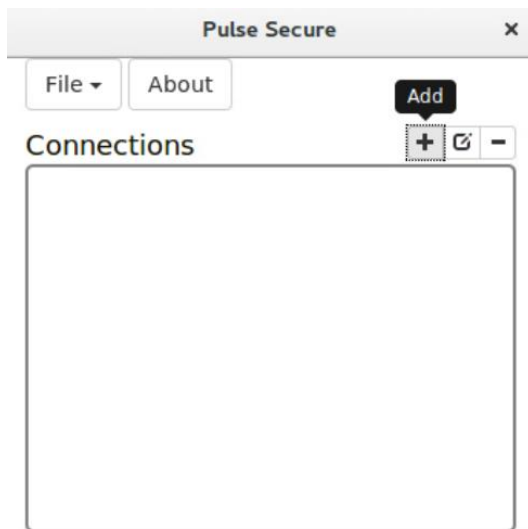

Next, open Pulse from your application launcher

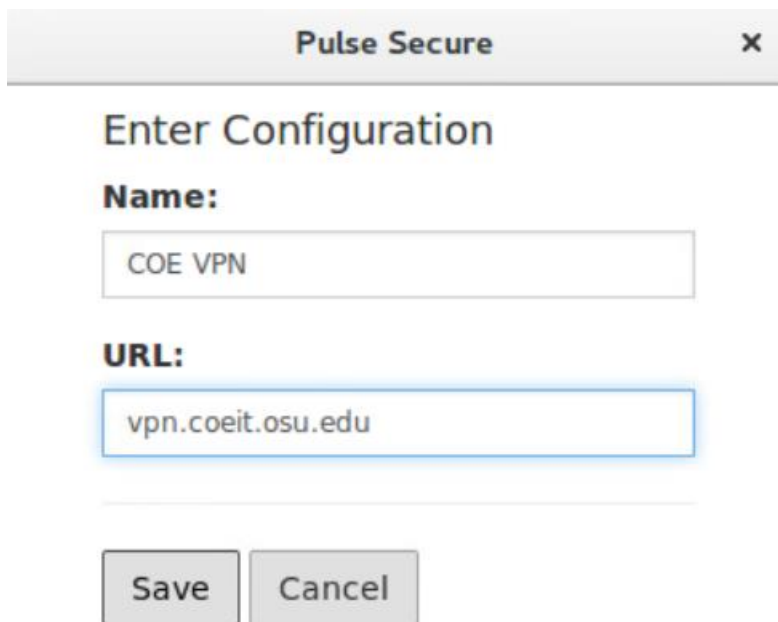


Once Pulse Secure is launched, click on the “+” to add a profile

Add a name and enter “vpn.coeit.osu.edu” as the URL



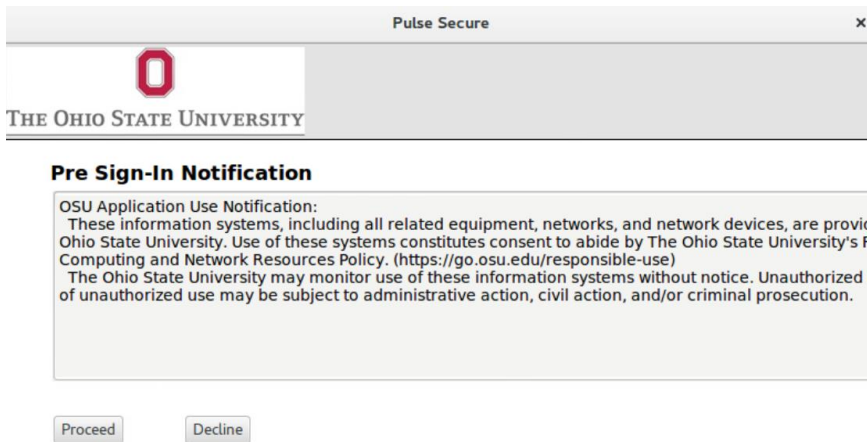

Once added, click connect.

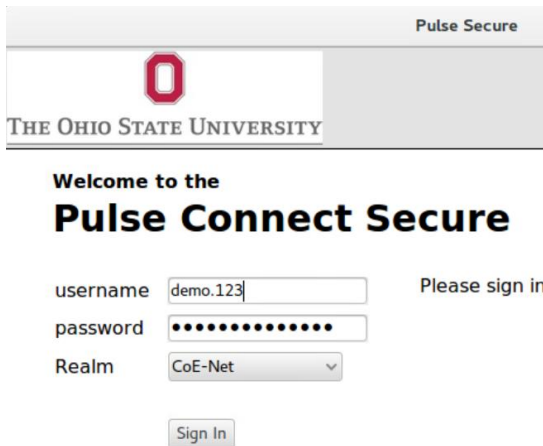

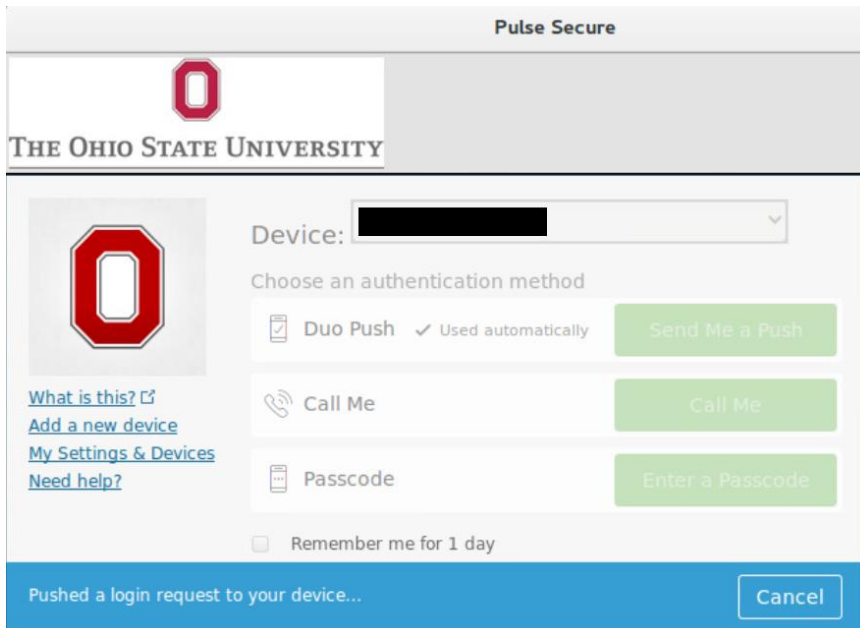
Accept the notification by selecting "Proceed"
